Registration of players is via the AFL endorsed PlayHQ Website.

If you have children in each age category you will be required to register using both links.

PAYMENT OF REGISTRATION

Payment for registrations will be completed online as part of your registration process. Simply follow the process on each website to make payment. If you are unable to pay online, then please come to the Registration Day on Sunday 20th February.

The following fee structure for the upcoming season will apply; please note male and female fees will be the same in the 2022 season.

Payment is to be made at the time of registering. If you register more than 1 child, you must pay the full amount (i.e., \$180 or \$190 per child) and then e-mail the Treasurer treasurer@kingsleyjfc.com.au to request a refund.

Player Fees:

Auskick (PP to year 2)

First player - \$176 (includes WAFC Player levy of \$16.50).

Modified Rules (Year 2 to Year 6)

First player - \$196 (includes WAFC Player levy of \$16.50).

Open Rules (Year 7 to Year 12)

First player - \$206.50 (includes WAFC Player levy of \$16.50).

Additional Player Discounts

Second Player - \$22 discount

Third & Fourth Player - \$66 Discount each

Fifth player - Free

(Please note your eldest child should be counted as your first child)

All fees include GST

KIDSPORT

When registering your children for all age groups select “Yes” to having a Kidsport voucher and enter it into the website. You will note that the prices at the bottom will be reduced to reflect the \$150 discount. Please also forward this voucher code to registrar@kingsleyjfc.com.au so we can match them.

For most parents there will be a small remaining amount to be paid. If you cannot do that via the online payment system, then please make plans to attend the registration day.

Those planning on using Kidsport need to apply NOW, not 2-3 days before registration day but right now as these vouchers can take 2-3 weeks to arrive.

Kidsport causes a massive amount of workload for the club volunteers, and we’d really appreciate it if people could do this now and have codes ready for registration day.

The basic process for Kidsport Registrations:

1. Apply for Kidsport via the DSR website.
2. Receive Voucher code and forward to treasurer@kingsleyjfc.com.au
3. Register online; enter code and pay difference via online payment system; alternatively attend registration day
4. Any difficulties then please plan to attend registration day with Kidsport code and PlayHQ login details.

We will not accept Kidsport registrations without a valid voucher code. To ensure you receive one in a timely fashion and your child is ready for the 2022 season please immediately apply online at the link below:

PROOF OF AGE/IDENTITY

For all new players to the football club, you are required to provide proof of age and identity via a birth certificate or passport. You can bring a copy or original down to the club rooms on registration day Sunday 20th February for Clair Berry or Renae Mudford to view.

Please note proof of age must be received by the club prior to the season commencing. Players will be ineligible to play until receipt.
